

Total amounts of funding 2,001.5 mio. €









GREENVOLT- CEF Alternative Fuels Infrastructure Facility (AFIF)

Total costs: 8.50 million EurosCEF grant: 2.55 million Euros

Starting date of the action: 01/12/2025
Ending date of the action: 30/06/2028



The project aims to contribute to the electrification of ground handling operations of the TEN-T core Frankfurt Airport (FRA), by deploying

- (a) eligible electricity supply facilities airside for stationary aircraft and ground operation vehicles (retractable fixed Ground Power Units (GPUs) 90kVA on 9 remote stands, 322 recharging points 21.3kVA AC for light ground handling electric vehicles (EV) in all apron and ground service areas),
- (b) on-site battery energy storage systems (BESS) 10 MWh, and
- (c) related necessary electricity grid connections inside the airport area.





Budapest Airport – CEF Alternative Fuels Infrastructure Facility (AFIF)

Total costs: 12 million EurosCEF grant: 6 million Euros

Starting date of the action: 01/02/2026
Ending date of the action: 31/08/2028



The project covers the electrification of ground handling operations and mobility services at Budapest Airport. It will equip aircraft stands with 16 fixed ground power units (GPUs) and passenger boarding bridges with 16 pre-conditioned air (PCAs).

It will deploy 4 high-power electric chargers of 100kW, enabling more environmentally friendly and efficient ground operations.





Stuttgart Airport / Airports Council International (ACI)

Total costs: 79.91 million EurosCEF grant: 23.97 million Euros

Starting date of the action: 01/07/2025Ending date of the action: 30/09/2028



This CEF Alternative Fuels Infrastructure Facility (AFIF) project involves upgrading infrastructure at Stuttgart Airport.

The project involves the installation of Pre-Conditioned Air (PCA) systems. The project will also incorporate synergetic elements such as photovoltaic panels and battery storage systems to provide renewable electricity at Stuttgart Airport.





RESILIMET

Total costs: 13.36 million Euros

CEF grant: 6.68 million Euros

Starting date of the action: 01/02/2025

The project concerns the improvement of the resilience and carbon neutrality of Budapest Airport by upgrading the existing storm-water drainage system.

The main benefit of the project is improved service quality by reducing the likelihood of airport disruptions due to flooding.





Tallinn Airport – CEF Transport Military Mobility



Additional fuel storage capacity and 4 additional wide-body aircraft stands for dual military / civil use, which allows an unhindered military mobility and at the same time permit uncurbed growth of civil traffic
